- Sorting, preparing and pricing donated items ready for sale
- Helping with merchandising and shop displays
- Serving customers and taking payment

Specialist roles:

If you have a particular interest, there are many specialist roles too. Here are just some to give you an idea of the variety on offer.

Book Worm	If you love books then this is the best role for you. Help sort, price, categorise and display donations to keep our shelves brimming with books.
Fabulous Fashionista	Are you mad about bags, head over heels for shoes or just love a bit of bling? If the answer's yes then we need your help to sort and process our accessory and jewellery donations.
Go Go Gadget Tester	Interested in devices, appliances and electrics? We're looking for a portable appliance tester (PAT Tester) to ensure our donated electrical items are safe and ready for sale. You'll receive a PAT qualification after your training.
Hauling Hero	To guarantee that our shop is filled with quality items, we receive regular van deliveries full of goodies for us to sell. We need help to carry these lovely donations from the van into the shop.
Homewares Hotshot	Help us sort through our wide range of household items – everything except the kitchen sink! You will be selecting and preparing items ready for sale.
Music Lover & Film Fanatic	Help us get all our fabulous donations of CDs, DVDs and vinyl ready for sale.
