## **Summary:**

Our Bucket Brigade volunteers help us with our community bucket collections.

Collections are not only a great way to raise much needed funds for us, but also a great way to connect with our local community.

The fundraising diary includes regular collections across the region; from Telford Town Centre and Shrewsbury's Asda to Morrisons in Welshpool.

The Bucket Brigade Ambassador will help set up collection points and be the main point of contact on the day for our Bucket Brigade collectors and for the venue community champion.

**Purpose:** To help generate vital funds for our services through community bucket collections.

**Commitment:** Bucket collections mainly take place at weekends (normally a Saturday) and some weekdays.

## Typical activities may include:

- Meet with the venue's community champion on the day of the bucket collection. This is usually at a supermarket.
- Set up and take down the bucket collection area. This may include erecting a table or stand, pop-up banner and displaying Severn Hospice promotional material.
- Be the main point of contact for our bucket collectors on the day welcoming and briefing at the beginning of their collection slots and thanking then at the end.
- Securely take the bucket containing the money from the collection and deliver to the nearest hospice site following all risk assessment protocol.
